16	DECLARATION OF CHARLES CARREON						
17	Charles Carreon declares and states as follows:						
18 19 20	I am an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of California, and the attorney for the defendant herein. I make this declaration on personal knowledge, and if called as a witness could and would so competently testify.						
21 22	2. In his opposition to this ex parte application, Mr. Levy asks the Court to give me only until						
23	December 12 th to file opposition to the motion for expenses and fees.						
24	3. This will not help the very much, because I am flying to Los Angeles on December 11 to						
25	meet with a client on Tuesday and Wednesday. A copy of my itinerary is attached as Exhibit 6.						
26	4. With regard to Mr. Levy's statement that I threatened him with "scorched earth litigation						
27	tactics," nothing could be further from the truth. What I told him, and which he redacted						
28	from my email, was that I am attempting to refinance my home, and but for the pendency of

this lawsuit, the refinance was a done deal. I said that if I lost my refinance opportunity because of this lawsuit, I thought that Public Citizen Litigation Group might be liable for negligent or intentional interference with prospective economic advantage. By that statement I was merely putting him on notice of the fact that his conduct could lead to liability for his employer.

- 5. The person who suggested that he might leave the earth scorched was Mr. Levy, who told me that if plaintiff's case herein were dismissed, he would appeal, and that he "loves to be on appeal."
- 6. I did not tell Mr. Levy that I have a reputation for "delaying litigation." Indeed, I believe I have a reputation for moving litigation along with alacrity. I simply told him, in response to his threat to take appeals, that I too have been litigating for some 26 years, and once engaged, do not tire easily.
- 7. Mr. Levy's statement in his declaration that he would "prefer to see any arguments that defendant may have about the claim for fees before advising plaintiff about his response to the offer of judgment" is not evidence relevant to the motion for an extension, but merely reveals his own strategic goal for refusing the extension request that I have been required to make to the Court.
- **8.** Finally, Mr. Levy's arguments about the law applicable to a Rule 68 Offer of Judgment are not relevant to the granting of the requested extension on the service costs motion. The only reason I mentioned the Rule 68 Offer of Judgment in my application for extension was to provide evidence that I have not merely been "talking settlement," but have in fact am sincere about settling the case, and therefore acted reasonably in not drafting an opposition to the motion for costs of service.
- **9.** Wherefore, good cause exists to grant the motion and issue an order in the form previously submitted.
- I hereby declare, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 1746 (2), under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States of America that the foregoing is true and correct.
